Highlights of the Week Ending 2nd, 9th & 16th May, 2016:

- Brief on OM dated 6th April 2016: The house was briefed on 2nd and 9th May for lodging grievance on Pensionersq Portal in CPENGRAMS with regard to full pension to the pre-2006 pensioners with less than 33 years of qualifying service. 8 such cases were registered online by the Association during the weeks. A model Application was circulated among the members for registration and redress. It is seen that Departments are not taking any *suo moto* action in the matter and the affected pensioner/family pensioner must apply to the Head of Department from where he/she has retired. This does not apply to post 2006 pensioners, as the qualifying service for full pension in their case is 20 years.
- <u>Swachh Bharat Pakhwada:</u> Swachh Bharat Pakhwada is being observed by all Ministries of Gol. DOPPW has requested all 43 Identified Central Govt. PensionersqAssociation to celebrate Pakhwada as per the guidelines issued in the letter dated 9th May.
- Swachhta Pledge by Association Members: Observance of Swachhta Pakhwada (Cleanliness Fortnight) was initiated on 16th by the members by taking Swachhta Pledge. Copies of the Pledge were given to members for taking the campaign forward by organizing meetings in their localities. 31 members present participated in the Pledge Ceremony.
