

**Activities of Central Government Pensioners' Welfare Association,
J&K,**

Highlights of the Week Ending October 26, 2015:

- **Registration of Grievances on Pensioners' Portal:** Three cases of Grievances were received from 3 Pensioners and the same were registered on CPENGRAMS (Centralized Pensioners Grievance Redress And Monitoring System) site of the Pensioners Portal after scrutiny:-
 - i) Smt Raj Rani: Wife of Late Shri U.C.Sharma, Retd. Sub Major who served in Department of Post, she is a family pensioner getting far less pension than her entitlement. Her case was earlier registered on 13.01.2015 which was disposed of on 25.08.2015 without any result, on flimsy grounds. As such, her genuine case has been registered online again.
 - ii) Shri Mohan Lal Sharma, Retd. Sr. Engg. Asstt., Door Darshan: An 80 year pensioner retired in 1993. He has not been granted revised pension as per OMs dated 28th January, 2013 and 30th July, 2015 in which the benefit of grade pay has been granted in favour of Pre-1996 pensioners w.e.f. 24th Sept., 2012 and Jan., 2006 respectively.
 - iii) Shri Naranjan Singh Bhalla, Retd Supervisor B/S, MES: He has pleaded his case for upward revision of his pension and grant of MACP with effect from 1.1.2006, the date of implementation of 6CPC.
- **Information on Latest Circulars/O.M.s:** The house was intimated about the latest O.Ms issued by Department of Pension & Pensioners Welfare (DOPPW). Shri S.S.Wazir, President of the Association was given copies of OMs dated 28.1.2013 and 20.8.2009 for sorting out some old cases which have come to his knowledge. The members were requested to meet the pre-1996 pensioners within their circles to verify whether they have received their upgraded pension. Any case not getting his/her due will be pursued by the Association online through registration on CPENGRAMS.
- **Weekly Talk by Shri S.D.Swatantra, IFS (Retd) & Shri K.B.Jandial, IAS (Retd):** Continuing with the series of Weekly Talks, two members delivered talks today:
 1. Shri S.D.Swatantra talked on Environmental Issues based on his long experience as Forester and as Chairman Pollution Control Board J&K. He also delved on the remedial measures which should be undertaken for healthy sustainable environment.

2. Shri K.B.Jandial gave a detailed talk on Accession of J&K State with Union of India which enjoys an irrevocable status in Constitution of J&K and that the Accession Day falling on October 27 every year should be celebrated by all in Jammu & Kashmir, including J&K Government. His well researched article on the topic has been published in Daily Excelsior of 25th October, 2015.
